Brighter Living Partnership will be relaunching the Crossens Fruit & Vegetable Co-Operative on Wednesday 1st July 12-4 p.m and every subsequent Wednesday. The co-op will allow affordable access to fruit, vegetables and salad and produce is sourced locally as possible and uses little packaging, reducing damage to the environment. The scheme continues to sell large bags of produce for £2.50 and is favourably priced when compared with supermarkets etc. The scheme joins our 2 other venues at Parenting 2000, 11-2 p.m on Thursdays and Ainsdale Centre for Health & Wellbeing on Fridays 11-3 p.m. We will also be looking at moving into the Formby area in the next few months.
