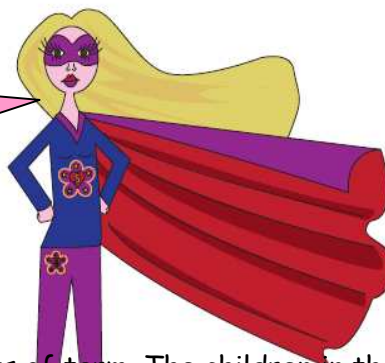
Hi, I'm Walk Dog and I'd like to tell you about the BIG Walk to School...
