Dear Parents/Guardians

Your child will be introduced to the BIKE IT project on Monday 5th October. It is initially a one year project which aims to encourage more children to cycle to school and generally increase their cycling skills and enjoyment.

As part of the project Mary Kelland, Your BIKE IT Officer will:

- Arrange cycle events such as BIKE IT Breakfasts, Pedal Picnics, Cycle Sports Day
- Arrange Bike to School Weeks and Days and lead local guided bike rides
- Offer BIKE IT assemblies and classroom projects linked to the National Curriculum
- Provide 'DR BIKE IT'- bike maintenance sessions
- Introduce basic bike skills practice in the playground to prepare children for future cycle training
- Access cycle training and maintenance courses for parents/carers.
