WELCOME BACK

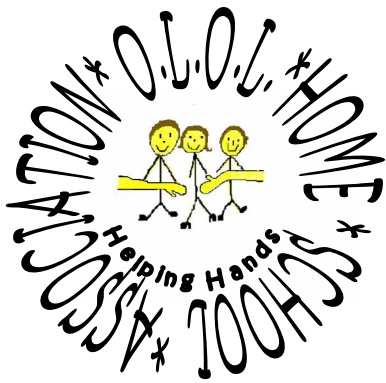
We would like to welcome back Mrs. Ward from maternity leave. She returns to teach in Year 2 working with Mrs. McMullan.
