Lost property will be displayed on the junior verandah all next week.

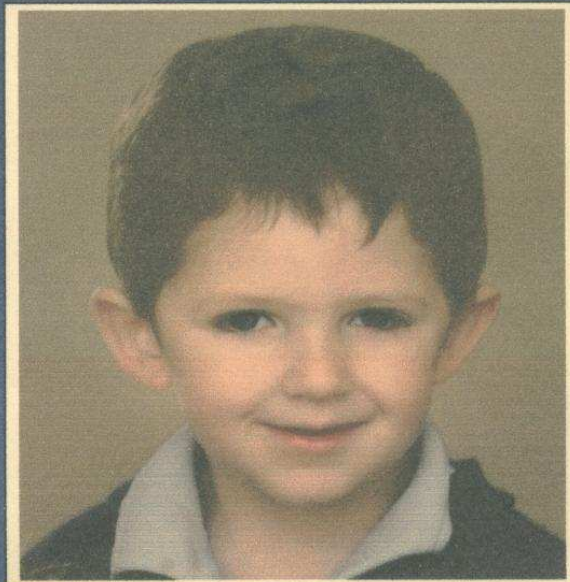
